The set will be transported with 14 m3 truck, which will arrive at the beginning of the set up. Please provide access and parking during set up and performances.

Set up


Please be sure that the stage is empty of all non-playing objects. Front black curtain with closable access and backdrop black curtain, must be set up before we arrive.

The set

- Playing area (mini): 9 x 9,50 m (flat, no slope)

- Height under pipes: 5,50 m (if less please consult us)

The set has been built and fireproofed by Olivier Benoit, builder, and is presented as follows:



- a pool with liner of 4.15×7.50 m, height 10 cm, with a dock. We put water in it (about 2 cm high)
- 2 risers of 7.50×0.80 m, height 20 cm, on each side of the pool.
- 1 desk room with 2 water tanks (2 x 200 liters).
- 1 triangular 300 trust, length: 6.50 m with video projectors and lights.
- 2 benches on wheels.
- Carpet all around the pool.

STAGE

This show welcomes the audience in the set, in immersion, the audience is barefoot.

It will be necessary to provide a space where the audience can remove their shoes and leave their belongings (bag, coat, etc.), the tier of the theater for example.

The cloakroom space and the stage will be separated by a black curtain, with a closable access.

The aera of our desk room must be able to support 500kg/m2. (Water tanks)


Material provided:

- the set (pool, risers, desk and water tanks).
- the triangular 300 trust with hang-ups.
- a cover sheet for your floor over the entire playing area.
- the carpets.

Material required:

- Black curtain at the back of the stage, black curtain separating the public cloakroom area from the stage area with a reclosable opening.
- Access between the public cloakroom and the stage area (stairs if the stage is high) as well as the equipment necessary for the safety of the public in the stage area (fences if the stage is high, etc.)
- 2 direct 240 V / 16 A power supply for water heating not during the performance (power and cables).
- 1 direct 240 V / 16 A power supply during the performances, in our desk room, via our trust (power and cables).
- 2 hanging points (150 kg), pipes, motors or other. h : 5,50 m.
- Water point (filling of the 2 tanks of 200 l) and evacuation point near the stage (< 20 m).
- Squeegees and water hoover welcome.

LIGHT AND VIDEO



Material provided:


- The entire video system: projectors, cables and video desk (laptop) except for 240 V / 16 A cables.
- The entire lighting system: projectors, dimmers and light desk (laptop) except 240 V / 16 A cables.

LIGHT AND VIDEO (continued)

Material required:

- 16 A cables to connect projectors and video projectors on our trust to our desk.
- 1 direct 240 V / 16 A power supply for the control room, via our bridge (power and cables).
- 1 direct 240 V / 16 A power supply for dimmers on our trust.
- 1 scale h: 5m for adjustments.
- Lighting for the public cloakroom area, dimmable, with DMX connection to our desk room if possible.

SOUND



Material provided:

Laptop and soundcard.

Material required:

- 4 professional quality speakers type MTD 115 with separate and adapted amplification, installed at the 4 corners of the stage, hanged (h: 4.80 m).
- -2 professional quality subwoofers type SB 115 with separate and adapted amplification.
- 1 compact digital sound desk type Yamaha LS9 which will be placed near the stage.
- 1 multipair 6 between the sound desk and our desk room via our trust.
- 1 AKG 451 type condenser microphone, with small stand.
- Power and microphone cables.

DRESSING / DRESSING ROOMS

Material required:

- Equipment, at our disposal, for the daily maintenance of the costumes: Washing machine, dryer, ironing board and iron.
- 1 dressing room for 2 actors.
- 1 dressing room for 3 technicians.
